Welcome to our latest Barne Barton newsletter which provides an update on our exciting regeneration plans for your local community.

Demolition of homes

You will have seen that demolition work has been taking place on blocks five (49 - 60 Talbot Gardens) and six (19 - 30 Roope Close) over the last couple of months.

We are delighted with the progress of this work which we hope will be completed by Christmas.

We are also planning the demolition of blocks seven (91 - 102) and eight (103 - 114) on Savage Road. We hope to start work in the New Year and will write to you again when dates are confirmed.

Building of new homes

We are working with the local council to agree planning conditions for the building of the first 28 new apartments. These will be built at the entrance to Talbot Gardens.

We hope we will be able to start work on these homes in the New Year.



You will likely see some activity on site between now and the New Year as the land is prepared for construction. We will provide more details about the new homes and dates when confirmed.
